Entries will be accepted as received. Your entry must be complete with BHA number and signed liability waiver. We reserve the right to limit entries to fall within the time constraints of a judging day, a maximum of 80 runs per day.

Classes offered Friday, Saturday, and Sunday: Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior, Master. Move ups will be allowed between trials. Facility will open at 9:00 am all days. Day of Trial entries will close at 10:00 am each day. Briefing will be at 12:30 pm and first dog on the line for Instinct Test at 1:00 pm. Classes will run in the following order: Instinct/Novice/Open/Senior/Master.

Entry fees are \$13 for Instinct and Novice, \$15 for Open, and \$18 for Senior/Masters . Day of Trial fees are \$5 additional per class. **Barn Hunt registration numbers are required for valid entry.** (Registration numbers can be obtained on the website: www.barnhunt.com.)

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for all Qualifiers in the Regular classes and the Instinct Test.

Placement ribbons will be awarded for First, Second, Third and Fourth place. Rosettes will be awarded for new titles. High In Class will be awarded for Novice, Open, Senior, and Master in each trial.

Exhibitor Information

1. Barn Hunt information, dog registration, rules and more can be found at www.barnhunt.com
2. The trial will be held outdoors, in a covered area on concrete. Bring what you need to keep yourself and dogs comfortable, ie chair, crate, shade, water, etc. Indoor bathrooms will be available.
3. Dog's minimum age to compete in the Barn Hunt Trial is 6 months of age.
4. All dogs must be under control and on a short leash while on trial grounds except while showing. **Flexi leashes and electric collars are not permitted** at the show site.
5. There is no smoking in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also.
6. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building.
7. **Bitches in season** may compete at Barn Hunt trials. They will be run at the end of each class. Bitches in season must wear pants. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.
8. Refunds offered only for injured dogs with veterinary note. Requests for refunds must be made by the closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
9. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "act of God" such as flood or fire, or civil disturbances or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, an event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation. We will return all or part of the entry fees at our discretion.
10. **Disruptive dogs** will have to be crated outside of the covered trial area. If your dog cannot handle other dogs or people walking past their crate, plan to crate outside the trial area. Please bring adequate shade.
11. Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited. If your dog is overly excited do not leave him/her unattended.
12. **Lunch will not be provided.** There are fast food restaurants and a grocery store approximately ten minutes away.
13. Bottled water and trail mix will be available for volunteers.
14. **Directions to the trial site:**
From North or South (Highway 89-91) – Turn west on 400 South go 5 blocks, turn left. Please enter fairgrounds from west entrances.
