Entries will be accepted in the order received. Your entry must be complete with BHA number and signed liability waiver. We reserve the right to limit entries to fall within the time constraints of a judging day, a maximum of 120 runs per day.

Friday afternoon Intro to the Rat: 3:00 PM registration; 3:30 - 6:30 PM. \$5/ dog. New to Barn Hunt or need some extra practice? This is your chance! Your dog does not have to be registered with Barn Hunt to participate.

Classes offered each day: Instinct Test (1 on Saturday and 1 on Sunday), Novice, Open, Senior, Master. Move ups will be allowed between trials. Saturday: Facility will be open at 7:30 am. Day of Show entries will close at 8:00 am for Trial 1, 11:00 am for Trial 2. Briefing will be at 8:15 am and first dog on the line for Instinct Test at 8:30 am. Trial 2 will begin at 12:30 pm, or one half hour after the end of Trial 1, whichever is latest. Running order for Trial 1 will be Instinct/Novice/Open/Senior/Master. Running order for Trial 2 will be Master/Senior/Open/Novice. Saturday trials will be run Tall to Small. Sunday: Facility will be open at 9:00 am. Day of Show entries will close at 9:30 am. Briefing will be at 9:45 am and first dog on the line will be at 10:00 am. Running order will be Master/Senior/Open/Novice. Sunday Trial will be run Small to Tall.

Exhibitor Information

1. Barn Hunt information, dog registration, rules and more can be found at www.barnhunt.com
2. The trial will be held outdoors, in a covered area on concrete. Bring what you need to keep yourself and dogs comfortable, ie chair, crate, shade, water, etc. Indoor bathrooms will be available.
3. Dog's minimum age to compete in the Barn Hunt Trial is 6 months of age.
4. All dogs must be under control and on a short leash while on trial grounds except while showing. **Flexi leashes and electric collars are not permitted** at the show site.
5. There is no smoking in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also.
6. Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building.
7. **Bitches in season** may compete at Barn Hunt trials. They will be run at the end of each class. Bitches in season must wear pants. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.
8. Refunds offered only for injured dogs with veterinary note. Requests for refunds must be made by the closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
9. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of an "act of God" such as flood or fire, or civil disturbances or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee, an event may be canceled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation. We will return all or part of the entry fees at our discretion.
10. **Disruptive dogs** will have to be crated outside of the covered trial area. If your dog cannot handle other dogs or people walking past their crate, plan to crate outside the trial area. Please bring adequate shade.
11. Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited. If your dog is overly excited do not leave him/her unattended.
12. **Pizza lunch will be provided.** For \$5 per person. You can order that morning.
13. Bottled water and trail mix will be available for volunteers.
14. **Directions to the trial site:**
FROM THE EAST: Take I-84 to Exit 182. Turn right onto ID Hwy 50. At the intersection of ID Hwy 25, stay to the left and continue to stop sign, then proceed straight onto Hwy 25. Continue 8.8 miles to county road 800 East. Turn right and continue 2.2 miles. Arena is on the left. FROM TWIN FALLS: Drive North on US Hwy 93 to ID Hwy 25. Turn left onto ID Hwy 25. Drive 2 miles, Turn slight left onto E 100 S. Turn left onto S 800 East. Arena is on the left. FROM WEST: Take I-84 to Exit 165. Turn left onto ID Hwy 25/West Road toward Jerome. Continue 7.3 miles (crossing US Hwy 93) Turn slight left onto East 100 South. Continue 2.3 miles. Turn onto 800 East. Arena is on the left.
